What happens next?

After the consultation, we will present a Consultation Report to the Secretary of State for Transport who will make the final decision on any recommendations and officially issue a Preferred Route Announcement by late 2016. The scheme is scheduled to be open for traffic in 2021-2023 depending on the option chosen. The preferred option will also be subject to a future consultation and public examination as part of the planning process.
